BE NOTIFIED THAT a Settlement Agreement for the Class action lawsuit *Roger and Victoria Marquez, et al v. Luisa J. Quintanilla, Administratrix, d/b/a Oasis Travel, et al*, Suffolk Superior Court, Civil Action No. SUCV09-1745-E, has been reached. The Agreement includes the following terms:

- The defendants will pay the plaintiffs a total of \$63,808.
- Of the total amount, the defendants will pay \$61,308 to the known victims, those individuals currently receiving restitution payments from the Chelsea District Court.
- The defendants will also pay \$2,500 that the plaintiffs will set aside for any victims that have not yet come forward.
- The plaintiffs will dismiss the lawsuit and no Oasis Travel victims will be able to sue the defendants for any additional amounts arising from the purchase of invalid airline tickets.

ALSO, BE NOTIFIED THAT:

- If you believe that any part of the settlement agreement is unfair, you have the right to object to the settlement, even if you have already authorized the attorneys to settle your fraud claim in writing or verbally.
- Plaintiffs' attorneys will conduct a presentation in which they will explain the Agreement in greater detail on **April, 20, 2011**, at **5:30 PM**, at the Chelsea Collaborative, located at 318 Broadway, Chelsea Massachusetts 02150. You are encouraged to attend the presentation in order to gain answers to any questions you might have regarding the Agreement.
- Thereafter, the court will conduct a fairness hearing regarding the settlement on **May 12, 2011**, at **2:00 PM**, at Suffolk Superior Court, located at 3 Pemberton Square, Boston, MA. 02108, Room # 304
- If you think the Agreement is unfair but do not act now, you will lose the right to later object or sue Oasis Travel for any additional amounts.
